

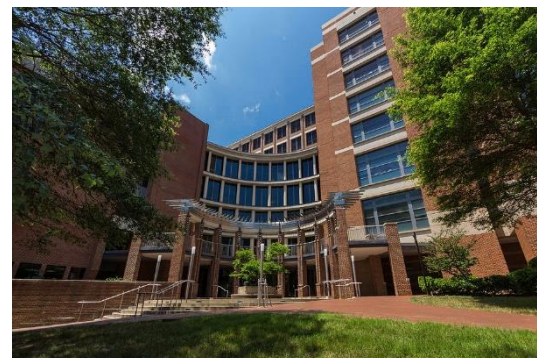
Directions and Parking Information for 2019 North Carolina Medical Genetics Association
University of North Carolina Chapel Hill

Location: NCMGA will be held at UNC's Molecular Biomedical Research Building (MBRB) this year.

On Campus Parking Options: Parking on campus is available in the Dogwood Parking Deck (across from the hospital). This parking is labeled "Hospital Patient/ Visitor Parking" on the map on the next page. The MBRB is only about a 5 minute walk from this parking garage. This parking is available at a cost of \$1.50 per hour to a maximum of \$10 to park your vehicle for a full day. We ask that you park on the upper levels to allow patients and their families to park on the lower levels. The entrance to the parking garage is located on East Drive and marked by the arrow on the map. You can also type "East Drive, Chapel Hill, NC" into Google Maps or "New East Drive, Chapel Hill, NC" into Apple Maps for directions to the Dogwood Parking Deck.

Park and Ride Options: The Town of Chapel Hill also offers fare-free busing from Park and Rides to the UNC Medical Center. Daily parking is available for 2\$ per day at Town of Chapel Hill Park and Ride locations. Please note that daily Parking is only available at Town of Chapel Hill Park and Ride locations and not available at UNC Park and Ride locations.

Directions from the Dogwood Deck to MBRB: Keep an eye out for signs that will be placed along the route. Exit the parking garage on the South side, onto Mason Farm Road. If you exit the parking garage and see Manning Drive or the Hospital, you have exited on the wrong side. Once you have exited the parking garage, take a right on Mason Farm Road and continue until you see Marsico Hall on your right (marked by a triangle on the map). Take a right onto the sidewalk immediately after you pass Marsico Hall. Then, take your first left, into the brick courtyard lined with trees and Taylor Hall will be on your left. Proceed towards the Courtyard until you see the MBRB on your left, photographed here and marked by a star on the map below.
